FILING FEE: Each form must be accompanied by a **\$40 FILING FEE** (check or money order only made payable to JLEC). Campaign funds **MAY** be used for this fee. If you are, or were, an employee (non-elected) of the General Assembly, or any legislative agency, your agency is required to pay the \$40 fee.

PENALTIES: Any person who fails to file a **complete** financial disclosure statement by the appropriate deadline may be assessed a late filing fee of ten dollars for each day the statement is late, up to a maximum of \$250.00, and may also be subject to criminal prosecution. In addition, any person who files a false statement may be subject to criminal prosecution.

FILING DEADLINES: The filing deadline is **Wednesday April 15, 2009**, unless one of the following applies:

An incumbent member of the General Assembly whose name will appear on any 2009 Primary Election ballot for local office. The filing deadline is thirty days prior to the Primary Election or April 15, 2009, whichever is earliest.

APPOINTEES TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY: Any person appointed to fill a vacancy for an un-expired term in the General Assembly must file within **15 days after he or she qualifies for office**.

EMPLOYEES: An employee of the General Assembly, or any legislative agency, must file by **April 15, 2009**, unless you were employed or promoted after that date, then you must file within **90 days after employment or promotion**.
