In addition, any person who files a false statement may be subject to criminal prosecution of a first degree misdemeanor.

FILING DEADLINES: The filing deadline is Monday, February 6, 2012, Unless one of the following applies:

AN INCUMBENT MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY whose name will NOT appear on the March 6, 2012, Primary Election Ballot. The filing deadline for incumbent members and former members who are not candidates is April 16, 2012.

APPOINTEES TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY: Any person appointed to fill a vacancy for an unexpired term in the General Assembly must file within 15 days after he or she qualifies for office.

EMPLOYEES: An employee of the General Assembly, or any legislative agency, must file by April 16, 2012, unless you were employed or promoted after that date, then you must file within 90 days after employment or promotion.

THIS FORM SHOULD NOT BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 2012. FORMS SUBMITTED PRIOR TO JAUNARY 1, 2012 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
